- 2. Bids received without EMD shall be summarily rejected.
- 3. The Successful Bidder shall furnish a **Performance Guarantee** (as per the template in **Annexure-VI**) in the form of Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank within a Week after issue of Letter of Award (LOA). The validity period and amount of Performance Guarantee are specified in the previous table.

3. METHOD OF SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1. The bids should be filled in two bid formats (Technical Bid and Financial Bid) with all the required documents as enclosures in separate sealed covers.
- 2. There should be the main envelope, called a Master envelope, and three more envelopes, namely: Envelope-1, Envelope-2, and Envelope-3.

- 6. Incomplete bids or bids not submitted in the prescribed format are liable for rejection. Also, the Bids received after the due date and time shall be summarily rejected.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. The bidder should have GST certificate at least 3 years before the date of issue of this tender. (**self-attested copy**)
- 2. The Bidder should have at least Two years of experience in undertaking similar civil works in Govt/PSU/Autonomous bodies.
- 3. The Bidder must provide a certificate of satisfactory performance from the above-mentioned organizations to which they have recently provided their services. Contact details of the person-in-charge from the previous clients must also be provided.

Note: - Here for S.I no 2 & 3, the decision of the Institute about experience matters will be final and no correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from bidders.

- 4. In the Last 3 years, the Bidder should have completed at least:
 - i. Three similar works/Services, each of value not less than Rs. 02 Lakh (OR)
 - ii. Two similar works/ Services each of value not less than Rs. 3 Lakhs (OR)
 - iii. One similar works/ Services of value not less than Rs. 5 Lakhs

Note: - Here for S.I no 4, Similar Service/works means Fixing of Meshes or relevant Civil Works

- 5. Bidder should be a registered contractor of CPWD/Andhra Pradesh State Govt. Departments and must have physical presence in Andhra Pradesh/Telangana/Karnataka. Valid supporting document must be submitted along with the bid.
- 6. A declaration undertaking on the Letterhead of the Bidder/Agency that all the terms and conditions as given in the tender document are acceptable and the firm has not been blacklisted by any of the organization at any point of time and no criminal case is pending against the said firm/agency (as per the template in **Annexure-III**) should be given.
- 7. Each page of the tender document along with all other submitted documents must be duly signed by **authorized signatory** with Bidder's company seal and initial, otherwise, the document will be invalid. (power of attorney, if any, to be submitted)

5. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

- 1. The Techno Financial bids will be opened as per the specified date and time in the presence of Bidders, who may like to be present in the Purchase section of the Institute.
- 2. A Committee duly constituted by the Competent Authority would evaluate the Technical bids submitted by the Bidders.
- 3. Prior to the detailed evaluation, the Institute will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the tender document. A substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the bidding/tender document and is without any material defects and deviations. Deviations from, or objections or reservations to critical provisions such as those concerning qualification/eligibility criteria, availability of facilities and amenities as needed, availability of government/statutory approvals and clearances, ready and explicit willingness to accept and honour the terms and conditions of contract etc. will be deemed to be material deviations.
- 4. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Institute and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
- 5. The Contract will be awarded to the L1 Bidder, i.e. the bidder who quotes least price among all the technically qualified bidders. The decision of the Director, IIITDM Kurnool, Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh, is final in this regard.
- 6. The Bidder should quote their competitive price in the financial bid in figures as well as in words.
- 7. Tenders with revised/modified rates/offer after the opening of the tenders shall be summarily rejected and the entire Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) submitted with the tender shall be forfeited.
- 8. The tender is not transferable under any circumstances.

6. DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scope : As per Annexure-I

Delivery Period: Time period for work completion within 60 days of issue of work order.

Instructions to Contractors:

- 1. Execution & completion of work: The entire work shall be carried out by contractor in accordance with the conditions and specifications stipulated in the W.O. and in the best workmanship manner and as per Indian standard code of practice and complete the work within the stipulated time. Materials required for satisfactory completion of work shall be of best quality, make, grade, as mentioned in quotation and / or conforming to Indian standard specification (latest edition), wherever applicable, and approved by I/O. The Institute reserves the right to reject the bad work / or pay for the inferior quality work at reduced rates, as will be worked out by Institute. The Institutes's decision in this regard will be final and binding on contractor.
 - a) The staff engaged by contractor shall be full-time technically qualified staff with adequate experience for the said work and should strictly follow the rules, discipline, and decorum of the Institute and contractor will be liable for any loss or damage caused by them to the Institute property. The Institute will not be held responsible for payment of any compensation as Contractor will pay all compensations etc. including accident compensations due to their labourers. The quality, time schedule for completion of work shall be essential & must for this project
 - b) Implements / materials required for the work shall be provided by contractor. Institute's property/materials shall not be used by the contractor. A suitable penalty shall be charged if contractor fails to observe this condition.
 - c) Contractor shall follow all safety rules and security procedure that are in force and applicable during execution of work.
 - d) The contractor shall comply with the provisions of all acts, statutes, rules, regulations etc., of the central and state governments the case may be that may apply to his case. And if necessary get himself duly register as require by the said acts, statutes, rules, regulations etc.
 - e) The contractor shall not cause or permit any nuisance on the site or adjoining areas or do anything, which shall cause unnecessary disturbances or inconveniences to the staff, students etc.
 - f) Contractor shall obtain necessary gate pass; labour tokens from the institute.
 - g) Contractor shall obtain prior permission for carrying out work on holidays.
 - h) The institute will be at liberty to cancel some of the items from the contract. In such cases, the contractor cannot claim any commission or percentage as profit.
 - i) The Contractor shall employ full-time technically qualified staff with adequate experience during the execution of the work. The quality, time schedule for completion of work shall be essential & must for this project
 - j) On the completion of the works the contractor shall at his own cost clear away and remove from the institute all their construction material, equipments, surplus materials, rubbish and debris created during the work.

Liquidated damages

The Institute reserves the right to impose 'LD clause' if the supplier fails to perform the contract within the specified period and can even terminate the contract on the whole or in parts thereof.

Indemnity

The vendor shall indemnify, protect and save IIITDM Kurnool against all claims, losses, costs, damages, expenses, action suits and other proceedings, resulting from infringement of any law pertaining to patent, trademarks, copyrights etc., or such other statutory infringements in respect of all the items supplied by them.

Bid Validity of both Technical and Financial Bids

Both the technical and financial bids shall remain valid for a period of 365 days after the date of Bid opening prescribed in the Bidding Document. Any Bid valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected. In exceptional cases, the Bidders may be requested by the Institute to extend the validity of their Bids up to a specific period. The Bidders, who agree to extend the Bid validity, are to extend the same without any change or modification of their original Bid and also needs to extend the validity period of the Bid Security accordingly.

In case the day up to which the Bids are to remain valid falls on or subsequently declared a holiday or closed day for IIITDM Kurnool, the Bid validity shall automatically be extended up to the next working day.

13. Penalty for delayed services / LD

- i) As time is the essence of the contract, the delivery period mentioned in the purchase order should be strictly adhered to. Otherwise, the LD clause will be applied/enforced.
- ii) If the supplier fails to supply, and fix the item as per specifications mentioned in the order within the due date, the supplier is liable to pay liquidated damages of 0.5% of the order value for the delay of every week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% beyond the due date. Such money will be deducted from any amount due or which may become due to the supplier.
- iii) IIITDM Kurnool reserves the right to cancel the order in case of delay and the contractor is not eligible for any damage from the Institute and contractor will forfeit his claim for EMD.

Purchaser's right to vary quantities at the time of the award

IIITDM Kurnool reserves the right at the time of award of the contract to increase or decrease the quantity of items specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in price or other terms and conditions.

Jurisdiction

The disputes, legal matters, court matters, if any, shall be subject to Courts in the district of Kurnool Jurisdiction only.

Force Majeure

- **b**) If the due date of submission of tender/tender opening is declared a holiday for the Institute, the due date for submission of tender/tender will be extended to the same time on next working day.

Arbitration

All disputes of any kind arising out of supply, commissioning, acceptance, warranty maintenance etc., shall be referred by either party (IIITDM Kurnool or the bidder) after issuance of 30 days' notice in writing to the other party clearly mentioning the nature of the dispute and will be referred to the arbitrator to be nominated by The Director, IIITDM Kurnool. The venue for arbitration shall be Kurnool.
