

## Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2024/B/4451927-C3

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. After award of contract - Successful Bidder shall have to get Detailed Design Drawings approved from buyer before starting fabrication. Successful Bidder shall submit Detailed Design Drawings for Buyer's approval, within 5 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, either approve the drawings or will provide complete list of modification required in the drawings within 5 days. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved Drawings with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of drawing- the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in approval of Drawing.
3. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
4. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
5. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
  1. Warranty: Minimum 1 Year
  2. After the award of the contract, the successful bidder shall have to visit the site of installation and submit a report/drawing detailing the number of Modular workstations that can be installed in the lab as per the requirements of the Institute.
  3. The bidder shall not be from a country sharing land border with India and if the bidder is from a country sharing land border with India the bidder should have been registered with the competent authority as per orders of DIPP OM No. F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020, and MoCI Order No. P-45021/112/2020-PP (BE II) (E-43780) dated 24th August 2020. A declaration shall be submitted with the bid as per format given in Annexure - 1.
  4. Only 'Class-I local suppliers' and 'Class-II local suppliers', as defined under DIPP, MoCI Order No. P-45021/2017-PP (BE II) dated 16th September 2020 and other subsequent orders issued therein, shall be eligible to bid in this tender. Declaration for Class-I and Class-II local suppliers should be submitted in the prescribed proforma format as per Annexure-2.

3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
