A detailed Profile, inter alia, including the following information is required to be submitted: A Teaching Plan, indicating industry-oriented skill-based courses from the curriculum of IIITDM Kurnool (available at www.iiitk.ac.in) that the applicant can teach and also an expanded statement of his objectives and long-term interests in coursework development.
